

MEDICAL LEGALIZATION FAILS--CBD EXPANSION

While medical cannabis failed, qualifying conditions for CBD use were expanded; taxed at 6%.

HEMP-DERIVED CANNABINOIDS • RESTRICTED

2023

SB 0378 passed restricting the sale of hemp-derived cannabinoids to minors under 21, retailers must maintain the products behind the counter; adds privilege tax, licensure requirements, and third-party testing.

Marijuana is classified as a Schedule I substance by DEA, meaning it has a high potential for dependency or misuse. Possession is a criminal misdemeanor, but there are limited legal allowances for nonpsychoactive CBD oil.
